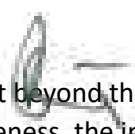

After the session, a live demo on CPR was performed on silicon human figurines (mannequins). This session showed us how to perform CPR differently on adults and infants. After that, police officers followed by students performed a live practical demo session which gave them a live experience on how to perform CPR as if the situation were happening in real life.

The event also gave the participation certificate to all the students present. Notes and manual were also given which contain detailed information on how to act in case of a medical emergency.

Now the Parties agree as follows:

A. NON-BINDING TERMS

B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is material to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know-how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information, with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction.

- Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU;
- Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser:

- Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

A) Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for the accuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied warranties of

Second party shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

5. Limitation of Liability

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

6. Intellectual property rights

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party.

7. Governing laws and jurisdiction

The Parties shall make efforts in good faith to amicably resolve all disputes as may arise out of or in connection with this MOU. This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the Indian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

8. Costs

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.

9. Amendment

This MOU may be amended at any time by the mutual written assent of the Parties.

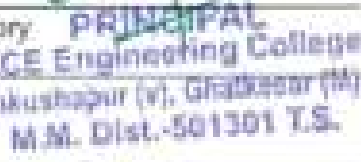

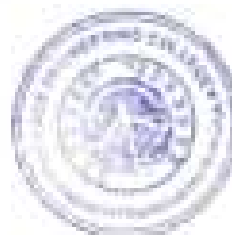

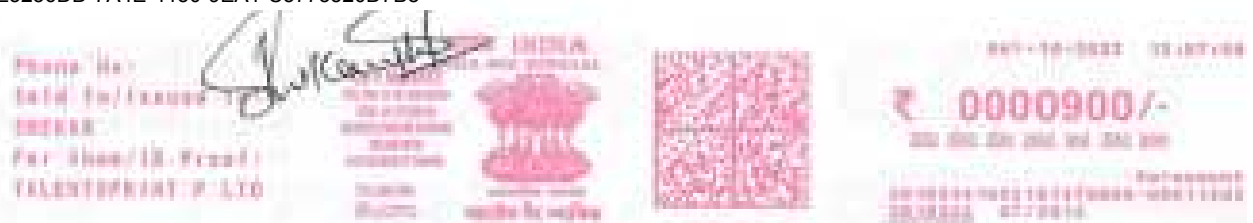

AND

ACE Engineering College, incorporated under the provisions of Yadala Satyanarayana Memorial Educational Society, and having its Registered office at Sy.No 175 & 181, Ankashapur (V), Ghatkesar(M), Medchal-Malkajgiri (Dt.), Telangana - 501301 represented by Prof. T Srinivasa Rao, Director Training & Placement cell, (hereafter known as the "Institution/Institute") which term shall, unless it be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, include its Affiliates, successors-in-office, successors-in-interest and permitted assigns) of the **SECOND Part**.

TalentSprint and Institution are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually referred to as "Party".

WHEREAS:

- A. TalentSprint brings transformational high-end and deep-tech learning programs to young and experienced professionals. TalentSprint's digital platform offers a hybrid onsite/online experience to seekers of deep technology expertise. TalentSprint partners with top academic institutions and global corporations to create and deliver world class programs, certifications, and outcomes. - D. Institution has requested to TalentSprint that they are keen to implement UAP in their organization in association with TalentSprint and on the basis of representations of Institution, TalentSprint has agreed to provide the said services to the Institution subject to the terms and conditions herein.
- E. The Parties are now desirous of entering into a definitive agreement for the purposes of documenting their specific mutual understanding and arrangements relating to the matter specified hereinabove and for that purpose are entering into this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties through friendly consultation in accordance with relevant laws and regulations and in the spirit of mutual benefit, honesty and good faith the Parties agree as follows: -

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION:

1.1. DEFINITIONS

"**Affiliates**" shall mean in relation to a Party, an entity which controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with such Party, where "control" means a person that directs the management and policies of the Party, through the ownership of at least 50% (fifty percent) of the voting securities or the ability to appoint majority directors on the board.

"**Confidential Information**" includes, without limitation, all products, services, process, invention, improvement or development carried on or used by either party, any and all technical data, system study reports, system requirements, specifications, designs,

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drawings, business models, discoveries, ideas, concepts, knowhow, research, samples, flowcharts, blueprints, any and all technology, computed programs, codes, algorithms, process, copyrightable materials, schematics, forecasts, strategies, employee details, participant or user information, business and contractual relationships, business partners, suppliers of services or any content, budgets, financial information, costs, sales or marketing plans and Intellectual Property Rights (*defined hereafter*), or other information, whether written or oral or in any format, belonging to one Party and supplied by such Party to the other Party in the course of this agreement either in electronic, oral or physical form, or which may come to the knowledge of the other Party by virtue of this agreement, whether or not specifically marked as being confidential. Confidential Information does not include information that (a) is in the public domain at the time it was disclosed; (b) was in receiving Party's lawful possession or known by it prior to receipt from disclosing Party, (c) becomes known from a third-party source, provided any such source is legally entitled to have and to disclose such information without restriction, or (d) was independently developed by the receiving Party without reference to any information received from the other Party.

"Course Material" shall mean the material prepared by Pega or TalentSprint in the form of printed or access to recorded digital/interactive multimedia provided to the Institution or students in any form.

"Force Majeure Event" means any acts or events beyond the control of the Parties and shall include but not be limited to the following events, i.e., civil disturbance, riots, strikes or lockouts, earthquakes, storm, tempest, other natural calamities, acts of God, emergency, epidemic and/or pandemic, quarantine restrictions, fire, civil commotion or unrest, terrorism, war, cyber-attack, blackout, expropriation or other governmental actions, any changes in the Applicable Laws or regulations, such that it restricts or prohibits either Party from performing its obligations as contemplated by this Agreement.

"Intellectual Property Rights" shall mean and include the rights in relation to a Party relating to intangible property, whether or not filed, perfected, registered or recorded and whether now or hereafter existing, filed, issued or acquired: patents, trademarks, trade dress, service marks, trade names and copyrights, data and applications, analytical methods, and all trade secrets and any other intellectual property right, including without limitation, the know-how, inventions, designs, new uses and processes, procedures and techniques, research, works of authorship, manuals, documentation, computer programs, software and codes and technical data and information.

"Law" shall mean any declaration, decree, directive, legislative enactment, order, ordinance, regulation, rule, judicial order, judgment, direction or other binding restriction of or by any Governmental authority, regulatory authority, statutory bodies, judicial or quasi-judicial bodies.

"Programme" shall mean the UAP incorporating Technical Course I and II technical Courses for on Pega's CSA, CSSA certifications as provided by TalentSprint and as more specifically provided under Annexure I of the Agreement.

- g. Reference to the word "include" shall be construed without limitation;
- h. Reference to days, months and years are to Gregorian days, months and calendar years respectively; and
- i. The Annexure annexed hereto shall constitute an integral part of this Agreement.

3. **TERM OF THE AGREEMENT:**

This Agreement shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of the execution of this Agreement (the "Term"). The Term is mutually renewable (in writing) on same terms and conditions unless otherwise agreed between the Parties in writing. During the Term of the agreement, the Programme implementation is subject to an annual written confirmation of continuity from TalentSprint.

4. **APPOINTMENT OF TALENTSPRINT:**

The Institution hereby appoints TalentSprint to implement UAP by providing technical courses to enrolled students of CSA and CSSA certifications in the Institution and provide services as more specifically provided under Annexure 1 and 3 of the Agreement.

5. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES:**

- 5.1. **Responsibilities of Institution:** The Institution shall be responsible for the activities and obligations as specifically provided under **Annexure 2.**
- 5.2. **Responsibilities of TalentSprint:** TalentSprint shall be responsible for the activities and obligations as specifically provided under **Annexure 3.**

6. **CONSIDERATION & TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

- 6.1. In consideration for the services to be provided by TalentSprint under this Agreement, the Institution shall pay to TalentSprint the fee per student per annum each for CSA and CSSA modules of UAP as specifically provided in **Annexure 4** ("Consideration").
- 6.2. The payment of Consideration under this Agreement shall be exclusive of any taxes as may be applicable from time to time (if any), which shall be paid by the Institution to TalentSprint as provided in the invoice raised by TalentSprint.
- 6.3. Any payment required to be made by the Institution under the Clause, if subject to any deduction of applicable taxes at source, and where the Institution so deducts taxes at source, the Institution shall promptly remit the same to the credit of TalentSprint within the applicable statutory due dates. The Institution shall strictly ensure statutory compliance in this regard.
- 6.4. In addition to the payment under Annexure 4, the Institution shall be responsible for payment of "Certification Fees" to Pega or to the concerned agency as may be appointed by them at the applicable rates from time to time. The Certification Fee shall be paid in advance before taking the certification test through the payment mode as required by Pega or the concerned agency appointed by them.

7. **REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES:**

- 7.1. Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party as follows: -
- 7.1.1. It has complete legal right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform its obligations hereunder, and this Agreement constitutes a valid, binding and enforceable obligation against it.
- 7.1.2. All necessary consents, approvals and authorizations required to be obtained by such Party in connection with the execution and delivery of this Agreement and the consummation of the transactions contemplated hereunder have been obtained; and
- 7.1.3. The execution and delivery of this Agreement will not result in the violation of any terms and conditions, or constitute default under applicable laws or other obligations by which it is bound, including any instrument or contract to which it is a party.
- 7.2. Institution represents and warrants to TalentSprint that-

- 7.2.1. It has adequate and necessary resources and infrastructure to perform its obligations hereunder;
- 7.2.2. The Institution shall not commit or omit to do any act which might inhibit restrict or interfere with successful implementation of the services of TalentSprint envisaged herein; and
- 7.2.3. The Institution has not entered into and shall not enter into any agreement during the Term, which might, directly or indirectly, in any manner whatsoever, which conflicts with this Agreement.
- 7.3. **Disclaimer by TalentSprint:** Nothing contained in this Agreement or implementation of Programme shall in any manner be construed to provide any representation or warranty from TalentSprint to assure any placements job offers from Pega or its implementation partners. Any such offer and selection shall be solely determined at the discretion of the Pega or its implementation partners, through a selection procedure as may be defined by Pega or its implementation partners and subject to its eligibility requirements.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS:

- 8.1. All Parties shall continue to hold and remain owner of their respective Intellectual Property Rights, on a perpetual worldwide basis, in any materials provided by each of the Party.
- 8.2. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, TalentSprint shall be the sole and exclusive owner of any Intellectual Property Rights in the Course Material or any other information or documents provided by TalentSprint under or pursuant to this Agreement.
- 8.3. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, Pega shall be the sole and exclusive owner of any Intellectual Property Rights in the Course Material or any other information or documents provided by Pega under or pursuant to the Programme delivered under this Agreement.
- 8.4. The Institution hereby acknowledges that any new concept, improvements or modification, whether by TalentSprint or the Institution or any of its staff/agent/representatives/Affiliates, to the Intellectual Property Rights of TalentSprint as provided under this Agreement shall become the exclusive property of TalentSprint, and shall inure to the benefit of TalentSprint on a perpetual basis.
- 8.5. The Institution shall provide all assistance to TalentSprint including signing any necessary documents and shall otherwise assist TalentSprint or any person designated by TalentSprint in transferring the Intellectual Property Rights mentioned herein above to TalentSprint or its designated person, as the case may be, unconditionally, irrevocably and in perpetuity. The Institution agrees to impose equivalent obligations on its Affiliates, personnel, agents, contractors, sub-contractors as applicable.
- 8.6. The Institution or any of its Affiliates, shall not in any manner make use of the Intellectual Property Rights of the TalentSprint which has not been expressly agreed between the Parties under this Agreement.

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8.7. The Parties agree that Clause 19(4) of the Indian Copyrights Act, 1957 shall be excluded for the purposes of this Agreement.

8.8. The provisions of this Clause 7 shall survive the termination of the Agreement.

9. TERMS FOR USAGE OF THE PLATFORM:

Programmes under this agreement may be delivered on TalentSprint Platform, IpearLai.

9.1. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Talentsprint hereby grants to the Institute during the Term, a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited and personal right to use the Platform. At the end of the Term or early termination of the Agreement, the grant of right to use the Platform will expire automatically and with immediate effect. The terms and conditions of the right to use the Platform shall be governed by the provisions as mentioned here under this Agreement.

9.2. The grant of right to use the Platform is only for the internal and non-commercial use. The Institute shall use the Platform only in relation to the Program, and to the extent required for fulfilling the terms of this Agreement.

9.3. This right to use the Platform by the Institute does not convey any proprietary interest / ownership in the Platform.

9.4. Institute shall not use the Platform or any information obtained or derived from it for any other business /commercial gain by creating a computer program or through any other mode/means to compete with the Platform.

9.5. The Institute shall not attempt to decompile, disassemble, alter, amend or reverse engineer the Platform in any manner whatsoever.

9.6. Institute acknowledges that Platform is a commercially valuable proprietary interest of TalentSprint and has involved expenditure of substantial amounts of money, which affords a commercial advantage over its competitors, and that loss of this competitive advantage due to unauthorized use or disclosure of the proprietary information would cause great injury or harm and irreparable loss to TalentSprint.

10. TERMINATION:

10.1. This Agreement may be terminated at any time during the Term, by mutual consent of Parties in writing.

10.2. In the event the Institution is desirous of terminating the Agreement, the Institution shall have the right to issue a prior 30 (thirty) days' written notice of termination only after payment of all dues to TalentSprint and TalentSprint provides a letter of confirmation to the Institution of clearance of all dues.



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- 10.3. In the event TalentSprint is desirous of terminating the Agreement, it shall have a right to terminate without assigning any reason by 'giving the other Party a prior written notice of 30 (thirty) days'.
- 10.4. Either Party will be entitled to terminate this Agreement in the event of breach of the terms of the Agreement by the other Party, provided that a written notice has been served on the breaching Party. In the event such breach is capable of remedy, the non-breaching Party shall have the right to terminate only after the breaching Party fails to repair or remove the irregularity within a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of issuance of the notice.

11. CONFIDENTIALITY:

- 11.1. All Confidential Information communicated and exchanged between the Parties in connection with the subject matter of this Agreement shall be received in strict confidence and will be used only for purposes of this Agreement, and that no Confidential Information will be disclosed by the Parties or, their agents, contractors or employees without the prior written consent of the other Party. Either Party may disclose Confidential Information only where it is:
- a. Required to be disclosed by applicable Laws;
 - b. Required to be disclosed by any government authority; or
 - c. Necessary to be disclosed to professional advisors, directors, employees of a Party in connection with this Agreement only for purposes of this Agreement.
- 11.2. Provided that Confidential Information will not include information which: (i) is in the public domain; (ii) at or prior to the time of disclosure by a Party, was known to the other Party through lawful means or through act of a third party who is free to make such disclosure without breach of any legal obligation; or (iii) is developed by a Party independent of any Confidential Information it receives from the other Party.
- 11.3. Without prejudice to aforesaid, each Party acknowledges that the other may receive legally binding demands from a law enforcement authority for the disclosure of, or other assistance in respect of, personal data, or be required by Law to disclose any personal data to any person and in such circumstances the disclosing Party will not be in breach of this Agreement for complying with such obligations to the extent legally bound. The disclosing Party shall notify as soon as reasonably possible of any such demand unless otherwise prohibited, such as a prohibition under criminal law to preserve the confidentiality of a law enforcement investigation.
- 11.4. It is clarified here that upon termination or expiration of the Agreement, the Institution shall immediately stop using the Intellectual Property Rights and Confidential Information of TalentSprint and shall immediately return all such information (including any copies thereof) to TalentSprint.
- 11.5. This Clause shall survive the termination of the Agreement.

12. INDEMNITY:



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- 12.1. The Institution agrees that it shall not contravene any applicable Laws or infringe upon anyone's legal rights while fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement and shall be solely liable for any such contravention of applicable Law or such infringement.
- 12.2. The Institution further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TalentSprint of any loss or damage to TalentSprint or its directors, employees, representative or Affiliates or in the event that any third party actions, claims, demands, costs, charges, damages and expenses (of every nature including attorney's fees and court costs), are brought against such Party or its directors, employees, representative or Affiliates under this Agreement in connection with any misrepresentation or the breach of the obligations of the indemnifying Party. Such Claim shall be made by the Indemnified Party by notice in writing ("Indemnity Notice") to the Indemnifying Party. In the event the Claim as set out in the Indemnity Notice is admitted by the Indemnifying Party, the Indemnifying Party shall make the indemnity payout within 60 (sixty) days from the date of the Indemnity Notice.
- 12.3. The Institution shall also take all necessary actions and support TalentSprint to defend any such action, if required by the Company. The provision of this Clause 10 shall survive the termination of the Agreement.

13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:

- 13.1. Under no circumstances shall TalentSprint be liable to Institution for (i) any indirect, incidental or consequential damages (including loss of profit or business), howsoever arising, whether under any law of contract, tort or otherwise, even if informed of the possibility of the same; (ii) the other party's lost revenues; or (iii) exemplary or punitive damages.
- 13.2. TalentSprint shall not be liable for any loss or damage that may arise due to the usage of hardware or any other material relating to the usage of the hardware in which the Program has been installed.
- 13.3. Except for breach of confidentiality obligations, breach of intellectual property rights, willful default, gross negligence and/or misrepresentation, in no event, will the total aggregate liability of TalentSprint to the Institution, in respect of Programme exceed the consideration paid in last one year from the date of such default/breach or Rs. 10 Lakhs, whichever is lower in relation to the Programme (as provided for in Annexure 1). TalentSprint shall not be liable for any Claims arising after the expiry of Term of the Agreement.

14. DATA SECURITY & PRIVACY:

- 14.1. Both Parties represent and warrant that its collection, access, use, storage, disposal and disclosure of any and all data, personal information of the counterparty and/ or any End User shall comply with the provisions of the Data Protection Legislation and all Applicable Laws, regulations wherever applicable at that time.
- 14.2. Further, unauthorized disclosure or use of personal information and/or personal data by either Party and/or any of its agents, employees, directors, or anyone acting on its behalf


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may result in substantial harm and liability to the counterparty and hence the counterparty shall be entitled to seek equitable relief (including an injunction) in the event of a breach or threatened breach of these provisions and claim any damages as and when required.

- 14.3. Both Parties agree to make reasonable efforts to maintain security and monitor all use (including unauthorized use) from its respective site and to communicate the terms of the usage guidelines to the students.

15. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is entered into on a non-exclusive basis and nothing in this Agreement shall restrict the right of TalentSprint to render similar services to any other person or organization. Institution shall not enter into any similar agreement with any third party in relation to the Programme provided or any other agreement which can result in breaching any of the obligations and warranties in this Agreement, without the prior written approval of TalentSprint.

16. NON-SOLICITATION:

During the Term and for a period of 2 (two) years thereafter, the Institution shall not, without the prior written consent of TalentSprint: (a) employ or attempt to employ any person who at the time is employed, or within the prior 6 (six) months has been employed by TalentSprint; (b) induce or attempt to induce any person to leave employment with TalentSprint.

17. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India, without regard to any choice of law or conflict of law provisions that would require the application of the laws of any other jurisdiction. Subject to Clause 14 (Dispute Resolution) below, any dispute arising under the Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts of Hyderabad.

18. DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

In the event that the Parties fail to resolve the dispute amicably within a period of 30 (thirty) Days. Either Party shall refer the dispute to arbitration of a sole arbitrator to be appointed by TalentSprint. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding upon the Parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The venue of the arbitration shall be Hyderabad and the arbitral proceedings shall be conducted in English language.

19. AMENDMENTS:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties regarding the subject matter of this Agreement, and supersedes all other prior agreements, understandings and negotiations, both written and oral, among the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement, may not be amended, nor any obligation waived, except by an instrument in writing signed by the duly authorised representatives of each of the Parties hereto.

20. ASSIGNMENT:



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Institution shall not assign this Agreement, or assign or delegate any rights or obligations hereunder, without the prior written permission of TalentSprint. TalentSprint shall be free to assign its rights and obligations under the Agreement to any of its affiliates.

21. SUB-CONTRACTING:

In case of subcontracting of any work or services by TalentSprint for the purpose of Programme or this Agreement, TalentSprint shall be authorized to outsource or subcontract the work without any requirement for approval or permission from the other Party.

22. SEVERABILITY:

In the event any term of this Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable under any applicable law or rule in any jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Agreement or any action in any other jurisdiction, but this Agreement shall be reformed, construed and enforced in such jurisdiction as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

23. STATUS OF EMPLOYEES:

At all times the employees and staff of the Institution shall be construed as employees of the Institution only and not of TalentSprint. TalentSprint shall have no liability towards the employees or staff of the Institution.

24. PUBLICATION:

The Institution shall not publish any articles or make any presentations or make any public announcement with respect to this Agreement or its association with TalentSprint without the prior approval of TalentSprint in writing.

25. CONDUCT OF THE PARTIES:

The Parties shall at all times ensure that the Parties or their employees or agents or Personnel observe good conduct, behavior, discipline and work together as a team during execution and implementation of the Agreement.

26. WAIVER:

The failure of any Party to exercise any right or to demand the performance by the other Party of duties required hereunder shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of any provision, condition or requirement hereof. No delay or omission of any Party to exercise any right hereunder on one occasion in any manner shall impair the exercise any such right on any other occasion.

27. FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither Party shall be responsible for failure to fulfil any obligation for so long as, and to the extent to which, the fulfilment of such obligation is impeded by a Force Majeure Event, provided that the Party subject to the Force Majeure Event: (i) has promptly notified the other Party of any circumstances which may result in failure to perform its obligations; (ii) could not have avoided the effect of the force majeure event by taking precautions which, having regard to all the matters known to it before the force majeure event occurred, it ought reasonably to have taken, but did not; and (iii) uses its best endeavours to minimise

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the adverse consequences that any failure in performance of its obligations might have, and to return the performance of such obligations to normal as soon as possible.

28. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES:

This Agreement is on principal-to-principal basis and (save where expressly stated in writing in this Agreement) nothing contained herein shall be deemed as any collaboration, partnership or agency between the Parties hereto.

29. ANTI-CORRUPTION AND ANTI-BRIBERY:

With respect to this agreement, the Parties acknowledges and agrees that the statutes of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 prohibit its students and employees/ officers from offering, paying or authorizing any financial or other advantage to be given to any official or employee of any Governmental Authority or political party, political candidates or employees of government enterprises (each, an "Official") for the purposes of (1) obtaining a proper business advantage; (2) influencing such Official to take, or not to take, any action or decision; or (3) inducing such Official to use his or her influence to affect any act or decision of a Governmental Authority.

30. THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY:

It is hereby agreed between the Parties that Pega shall be entitled to claim the benefit under Clause 5.4 as a third party beneficiary in spite of not being privy to this Agreement.

31. FURTHER ASSURANCES:

The Institution shall from time to time execute and deliver all such further documents and do all acts and things as TalentSprint may reasonably require to effectively carrying out the full intent and meaning of this Agreement.

32. COUNTERPARTS:

The Parties may execute this Agreement in counterparts. Each counterpart shall constitute an original document, and all counterparts shall constitute one and the same agreement.

33. NOTICES:

All documents, approvals, consents and notices to be provided under this Agreement must be given in English and must be sent in writing by Hand delivery to the notified person, fax, E-mail, Courier, first class airmail, postage prepaid, by either Party hereto, to the other at the addresses mentioned above unless specified otherwise. Also in case of a change of address the Party shall inform the other Party, in writing, about the change of address.

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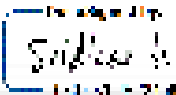
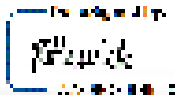

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Memorandum of Understanding Industry - Academia Partnership

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is executed on this 5th of November 2024

BETWEEN

Mr. TVS Durga Prasad, duly constituted under ACE Engineering College having its campus and office at Ghatkesar, hereinafter referred to as the "College/First Party", which expression shall where the context so admits includes its successors in interest and permitted assigns.

AND

Movate Technologies Private Limited, a company registered under the Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at 6th Floor, 32A&B, Ambit IT Park, Ambit IT Park Road, Ambattur Industrial Estate, Chennai – 600058, Tamil Nadu, India, hereinafter referred to as "Movate" / "Second Party", which expression shall where the context so admits includes its successors in interest and permitted assigns.

Hereinafter referred to jointly as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party" to this MOU.

WHEREAS

ACE Engineering College stands out as an Institute of academic excellence by imparting technical, intellectual, and professional skills to the students, offers a distinguishing blend of premium graduate, undergraduate and research programs.

Movate is a global Information Technology, Consulting and Digital Solutions company that provides IT and business consulting, application support and maintenance, development, systems integration, and managed services to its customers.

The College is desirous of placing its students in Movate through Campus Placement - a program conducted within universities and educational institutions to provide jobs to final year passing out students. The educational institution wishes to partner with Movate for recruitment of its final year student population.

Movate is desirous of identifying and nurturing suitable talent from the College who will be considered for placement to Movate after graduation.

This MOU is intended to be legally binding between the Parties and is enforceable in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.

Accordingly, the Parties have decided to reduce into writing their mutual  negotiations and understanding as stated hereunder.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

Objective:

The over-all objective of this MOU is to ensure:

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1. Movate offers an Industry Readiness Program to final year shortlisted students to gain exposure on trending technologies like Cyber Security, Digital Engineering Services, Infra Structure Services and Consumer Technical Support.
 2. Students from the College who meet the eligibility criteria of Movate will be shortlisted and given access to the Movate Virtual Academy - iAcceleratePortal on the technology of interest for Movate.
 3. Placement opportunities for students in Movate upon successful completion of Industry Readiness Program as per defined threshold.
 4. Trained and ready to deploy talent availability for Movate.
 5. Movate representatives to be in Board of Studies of College to guide and mentor the students in developing talent and make them industry ready.
 6. Movate employees to participate in the technology symposiums and guest lectures to bridge the gap between academia and industry.
 7. Provide opportunities to students to be groomed and mentored by industry experts.
1. The Parties on this day have executed this MOU to establish a partnership with an intention to enhance the capability of the students selected for Movate from the College through an **Industry Readiness Training Program**, focused training for the pre-selected students with support from the College POC who will be oriented by Movate subject to the following **Terms and Conditions**:
- a. The college partners with Movate to conduct Industry Readiness Program on technologies like CyberSecurity, Infrastructure & Cloud Services, Digital Engineering Service and Consumer Technical Support (Refer Annexure 2).
 - b. The Program Sponsors for the agreed programs shall be the Head of Training & Placement Department from the College and Head Campus and Institutional Alliance from Movate.
 - c. The Final year students of any Engineering Course with Computer Science/ IT as specialization who are to be trained shall be pre-selected by Movate (hereinafter referred to as the "Pre-selected Students") as per Movate's eligibility criteria and selection process and a Conditional Offer Letter will be given to the Pre-selected Students which will specify the conditions to be complied with to join the organization.
 - d. Students will be stack ranked based on their performance and the top performing students from the training program who qualify may be selected into Movate roles, subject to the policies of Movate. Movate will have the final say based on the individual performance of the students in this regard. All final selections for the offer will be subject to selection in the final Movate recruitment process.
 - e. Movate will provide the pre-selected students with access to the iAccelerate Portal with the required e-learning courses for the Industry Readiness Program with training content, industry-academia exposure, and support events to uplift the capability of the Pre-selected Students.



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- f. Refer Annexure-1: Campus Connect Collaboration Plan is a list of recommended programs by Movate which aims to make the Pre-selected Students industry ready. Movate recommended programs will be implemented for the Pre-selected Students.
 - g. The College shall not charge the Pre-selected Students any fee for this course. If it is found that the College has charged fees for this program from students, Movate shall have the right to terminate this MOU and/or pursue other remedies available under the law, against the College.
 - h. Movate would do an initial screening process and shortlist students for the Industry Readiness Program. The shortlisted students, would be given a conditional offer letter, confirming their selection into the program.
 - i. Movate shall have the discretion to make full time employment offers to any of the Pre-selected Students upon successful selection in Movate 's recruitment process, the Industry Readiness Program, subject to completion of their graduation. Movate shall not be under obligation under this MOU to recruit any fixed number of Pre- selected Students.
 - j. The program involves substantial efforts and investment and continuous engagement from Movate with the intent to develop and hire substantial number of students from the College. The College shall therefore, take all necessary steps to ensure that at least 70% of the pre-selected Students join Movate after successful completion of the training. A drop in the joining percentage below the expected level will seriously jeopardize Movate 's interests and may be a material reason to not continue the engagement in the following years.
2. The MOU shall be valid for three (3) years from the date of execution. Movate shall have the right to terminate this MOU for convenience and in the event of breach of material obligations including confidentiality obligations by the College by giving a notice of fifteen (15) days, provided that the breach is not remedied by the College within such period.
 3. The Parties herein have agreed to perform various obligations for the purpose outlined in the MOU and there is no monetary obligation/consideration involved herein between the Parties. The College shall bear all expenses towards providing infrastructure, network and internet access, other facilities required for education and training and such other expenses incurred in performing its obligations under this MOU.
 4. Under no circumstances shall the Parties be treated as the vendor, employee, contractor, representative and agent of the other. This MOU does not create any other legal relationship of employer/employee, partnership, or joint venture between the Parties herein, other than the relationship contemplated by this MOU. The College do not have any right to obligate or bind Movate in any manner nor the College have the right to act as an agent or representative of Movate.
 5. Any information or documentation received by the College during the term of this MOU shall be deemed as "Confidential Information" under this MOU. The Confidential Information includes, but is not limited to, any information, course material, plans, discussions, strategies or any material provided by Movate or its partners to the College, and Movate 's technology including discoveries, inventions, research and development efforts, manufacturing processes, hardware/ software (regardless of media) design and maintenance tools and hardware/software product know-how, which may be disclosed by Movate to the College during the subsistence of this MOU. Confidential Information shall also include any information marked "Confidential" or "Proprietary" but does not include any information already in the public domain or such information which was obtained from a third party. The College shall not disclose, reproduce, and use any Confidential Information for any purpose except solely in connection with the performance of its obligations under this MOU. Upon expiration or termination of this MOU, the College shall cease using all such Confidential Information and shall either destroy or return all copies of such Confidential Information, in whole or in part, to Movate. Any of its personnel/ students/ faculty shall not disclose the Confidential Information during the term of this MOU and thereafter.

The Parties shall not make unauthorized use of the trade name, trademark, copyright, patent, symbol, licenses, or designation belonging to the other party without prior approval and permission. In the event, the College or any of its personnel/ students/ faculty breach its confidentiality obligations or infringe the intellectual property of Movate, Movate shall have the right to pursue appropriate remedies available at law and shall be entitled to equitable relief. In addition, the College shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Movate, from and against all claims and all losses, liabilities, obligations, damages, expenses and costs (including without limitation reasonable legal fees) brought against or suffered by Movate or any of its respective officers, directors, employees, partners or agents, resulting from, arising out of or relating to breach of confidentiality obligations, applicable laws and regulations and infringement of intellectual property.

6. Movate shall provide requisite publicity material such as handouts, information brochures and posters, if applicable to the College. Upon expiration, termination of this MOU or when requested by Movate, the College shall cease using all such material and documents and it shall immediately return all copies of the documents, in whatever form, to Movate.
7. Neither of the Parties shall use the name of the other Party in any advertisement nor make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other Party.
8. Movate may have similar collaborations with other institutions and this MOU is not exclusive.
9. The College may have similar collaborations with other companies so long as Movate's interests are not compromised, confidentiality of the knowhow and processes are maintained, the Pre-selected Students alone are put through Movate training curriculum and made available exclusively to Movate for its recruitment process.
10. The College shall take all necessary steps to safeguard the interest of Movate by avoiding any conflict of interest with other competing companies.
11. Except as expressly stated in this MOU, there shall be no obligation on either of the Parties to compensate the other in any manner or any claim. However, the terms and the conditions in this MOU shall be kept confidential.
12. The Parties agree that no party shall be held liable for any act or omission of the other party under this MOU.
13. The Parties represent that they have the full power and authority to enter this MOU in general and none of the objects stipulated herein are against public policy.
14. The Parties shall designate their respective /representatives who shall be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party as below:

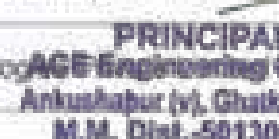

The seat of arbitration shall be Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India, and the arbitration shall be conducted in English language. In case, the dispute cannot be settled amicably, this MOU shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Chennai.

18. **Force Majeure.** Neither Party shall be liable for any loss, damage or penalty resulting from delays or failures in performance of their obligations under this MOU if the failure results from events beyond the reasonable control of either Party. For the purpose of this MOU, such events shall include, but are not limited to acts of God, war, hostility, invasion, act of foreign enemies, rebellion, revolution, riots, civil war or disturbances, acts of civil or military authority, laws, regulations, pandemics, epidemics, COVID-19, acts or orders of any governmental authority, body, agency or official, fires, inclement weather, rain or floods (however caused), strikes, lock-outs or other Labour disputes, epidemics, outbreaks, embargoes or other catastrophes affecting the availability of materials or Labour necessary for the performance of this MOU. The Parties hereto agree to notify the other Party promptly of any such circumstances delaying its performance and to resume performance as soon thereafter as is reasonably practicable.

19. **Anti-Bribery Compliance:** The College acknowledges that Movate conducts its business in ethical manner and has no tolerance against bribery and corruption. ACE Engineering College Ghatkesar was established by Madala Suryanarayana Venkatesh Educational Society as an autonomous engineering college under Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University in Telangana, represented by its Prof. Y. V. Gopala Krishna Murthy, an Educationist, Engineer and founder of ACE Engineering Academy hereinafter referred as "CLIENT COLLEGE", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its partners, successors and permitted assigns;

Whereas Consultant Company is into the business of providing aspiring entrepreneurs with the comprehensive support they need to turn their innovative ideas into successful businesses as well as providing services of professional training, consultancy, research, Human Resource, Job Placements and Information services in different industry segments and also running programs like Young Founders Lab, University labs etc., and further providing Strategy & Advisory to Colleges, Universities and Students/ Individuals.

And Whereas Client College is looking for the services that are provided by the Consultant Company more specifically to implement Young Founders Lab program and managing the incubation center at Client College.

NOW THEREFORE CONSULTANT COMPANY AND CLIENT COLLEGE HERCINAFTER AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definitions

1.1 "Party" shall mean either CONSULTANT COMPANY or CLIENT COLLEGE and "Parties" shall mean both CONSULTANT COMPANY and CLIENT COLLEGE.

1.2. "Consultant Company Services" shall mean and include a) promoting the on campus incubation center by creating Start up, innovation ecosystem, b) Start-up Creation and Incubation, c) providing education, training

- 1.3 "Confidential Information" shall mean any information, including and not limited to business plan, strategy, business method, data, client list, customer information, financial information, program, formula, pattern, design, configuration, architecture, algorithm, compilation, circuit, device, method, technique, or process which is disclosed by the Disclosing Party to the Receiving Party.

Exclusion:

Confidential Information shall not include:

- i) The information which is in the public domain or comes into the public domain otherwise than by disclosure or default by the Receiving Party; or
- ii) The information which was or is lawfully obtained by the Receiving Party or available from a third party who was lawfully in possession of the same and free to disclose it; or
- iii) The information, which was already known to the Receiving Party and has been received from a source other than the Disclosing Party.

- 1.4 "Disclosing Party" shall mean the Party that discloses Confidential Information to the other Party.

- 1.5 'Receiving Party' shall mean the Party that receives Confidential Information from the Disclosing Party.
- 1.6 'Intellectual Property' shall mean any Patents, Copyrights, Integrated Circuits, Confidential Information, Trademarks and so on owned or in the process of being acquired or might be acquired in the future by any party.

2. Collaboration

- 2.1 Consultant Company and Client College hereby agree to collaborate in providing Young Founder Lab Program, workshops, training programs, and other consulting services. The complete set of services of Consultant Company and deliverables will be provided as Annexure-I to this agreement.
- 2.2 The parties agree to promote and conduct business in a transparent manner for mutual benefit.

3. Responsibilities of Client College

- 3.1 Client College shall provide infrastructure and tools and support services for administering, conducting the Young Founder Lab Program workshops, training programs, and other consulting services.
- 3.2 Client College shall provide software tools and hardware equipment required to deploy and for conducting the Young Founder Lab Program workshops, training programs, and other consulting services.
- 3.3 Client College shall provide all Logistics for workshops, Hackathons and Ideathons that are to be conducted as part of the services by the Consultant Company.

- 3.4 Client College Ensuring Student participation and Faculty Participation in all the programs designed for them by the Consulting Company.
- 3.5 Client college shall provide all the required Equipment Computers, Printer and Stationery for the resources placed and material printing etc., for implementation of the Consultant Company services.
- 3.6 Client College shall allowing the usage of auditoriums in the college for events related to start ups and other services of the Consultant Company under this agreement.

4. Responsibilities of Consultant Company

- 4.1 Consultant Company shall design and deploy the curriculum and conduct workshops training programs and consulting services in coordination with the Client College.
- 4.2 The Consultant Company shall ensure to creation of Start-ups, Innovation ecosystem in the Client College.
- 4.3 The Consultant Company should allow networking and bring mentors and technical guest speakers for Client College.
- 4.4 The Consultant Company shall ensure for getting investments pitching, Grant advisory and capacity development of the Faculty to raise Grants and establishment of sustainable fund flowing into the Client College.
- 4.5 The Consultant Company shall Facilitate Internships, University, and international pitch competitions for students of the Client College.
- 4.6 The Consultant Company shall provide the technical mentoring, monthly Progress review and updating the Client College's Student Clubs & Mentor for Entrepreneurship Development.

- 4.7 The Consultant Company shall facilitate industry partnerships with the Client College where applicable.
- 4.8 The Consultant Company shall make its faculty, technical personnel and delivery personnel available at Client College premises for processes, workshops, training programs and consulting services.
- 4.9 The Consultant Company shall prepare the necessary action plan and take prior approval of the budget for its promotional, advertisement and marketing activity.

5. Joint Responsibilities

- 5.1 Client College and Consultant Company shall jointly devise and develop workshops, training programs and consulting services.
- 5.2 Client College and Consultant Company shall be preferred partners globally in the area of providing workshops, training programs and consulting services.
- 5.3 Once the workshops, training programs and consulting services announced both parties shall perform the duties assigned by this agreement without fail. Parties cannot withdraw from performing their obligation under the agreement once signed this agreement. In case of such withdrawal the Client College must pay complete consideration as agreed under this agreement.
- 5.4 As the program deliverables depends on the participation of students and faculty, there might be delay in expected deliverables but both parties shall discuss time to time to ensure the given outcome of the program.

6. Consideration.

6.1 The Client College and Consultant Company has agreed INR. 20,00,000 / (Indian Rupees TWENTY LAKHS) INCLUDING TAXES will be tendered for 10 Months in the account of Ms. Sakuntala Kasaragadda , A/C # 139302002, Sakuntala Kasaragadda IFSC: SBIN0020545, Branch : Raidurg as complete consideration for the services rendered by the Consultant Company to Client College. If there are any variations in the services or any additional services provided by the Consultant Company, the parties shall agree on the pricing and once agreed on the prices shall execute the schedule of fee sheet which will be annexed to this agreement and will be treated as part and parcel of this agreement.

6.2 The Client College has agreed to make the payment of complete consideration amount under this agreement to the Consultant Company as follows:

- a) One Month advance at the time of signing contract
- b) Remaining for 5 months or 1st of every month

6.3 The Consultant Company shall raise invoices to the client College from time to time as per the payment schedule agreed in clause 6.2 herein above.

7. Confidentiality

7.1 Either Party may disclose or receive Confidential Information under this Agreement.

7.2 Receiving Party shall maintain Confidential information in confidence and will protect Confidential Information with the same degree of care as Receiving Party uses to protect its own Confidential information.

8.0. & 13 AGREEMENT - Confidential

- 7.3.1 Receiving Party may disclose Confidential Information to its employees, consultants, or contractors, to whom it is necessary to disclose this information for the purpose of providing IT Infrastructure services under this agreement.
- 7.3.2 Receiving Party shall make such disclosures only under terms at least as restrictive as those specified in this Agreement.
- 7.4 Receiving Party may disclose Confidential Information if required to do so by law, regulation, or court order.

8. Intellectual Property

- 8.1 Each Party may use Intellectual Property of the other Party for purposes of providing services under this agreement i.e., Workshops and Training Programs and consulting services under this agreement.
- 8.2 All Intellectual Property owned by any Party before the Effective Date of this agreement shall continue to be owned by that Party.
- 8.3 Any Intellectual Property generated within the scope of this agreement shall be owned independently by the Party that generates such Intellectual Property.

9. Non-Competition and Non-Solicitation.

- 9.1 The Client College agrees that the nature of the Consultant Company is confidential, proprietary, and trade secret information to which the Client College has, and will continue to have, access to derives value from the fact that it is not generally known and used by other in the highly competitive, international industry in which Consultant Company

competes. The Client College further acknowledges and agrees that, even in complete good faith, it would be impossible for the Client College to work in a similar capacity for a competitor of Consultant Company without drawing upon and utilizing information gained during the engagement with Consultant Company. Accordingly, at all times during the engagement of Client College with Consultant Company and for a period of five years after termination, for any reason, of such engagement, the Client College will not, directly or indirectly:

- b) Either alone or in association with others (i) solicit, or facilitate any organization with which the Consultant Company is associated in soliciting, any employee or consultant of Consultant Company (ii) solicit for employment, hire or engage as an independent contractor, or facilitate any organization with which the Consultant Company is associated in soliciting for employment, hire or engagement as an independent contractor, any person who was employed or engaged by Consultant Company at any time during the term of this agreement or engagement of client college with Consultant Company; or (iii) solicit business from or perform services for any customer, supplier, licensee or business relation of consultant Company, induce or ~~as a PRINCIPAL~~ induce.

10. Governing Law and Arbitration

10.1 This Agreement, and any dispute, controversy, proceedings or claim of whatever nature arising out of or in any way relating to this Agreement or its formation shall be governed by and construed in accordance with laws in force in India. This agreement is subject to the Jurisdiction of Courts in Hyderabad.

10.2 The parties shall endeavor to settle any dispute arising in connection with the interpretation, performance, and termination of this agreement or otherwise in connection with this agreement through friendly consultations, negotiations and mediation. If no settlement is reached within a period of 60 days and both the Parties are of the view that there is no scope for a resolution, then the dispute shall be finally settled by arbitration under the (Indi an) Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

11. Term and Termination

11.1 This agreement shall be valid for a term of 12 months from 21st August 2022 to 20 August 2024 and can be extended on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

11.2 This agreement may be amended at any time by the mutual written consent of the parties and all such amendments shall be in writing and duly endorsed by both parties.

11.3 The parties shall review this agreement in case of extension; every year to determine whether it should be revised, renewed or terminated.

- 11.4 Either party may terminate this agreement by providing 60 days' written notice to the other party.
- 11.5 On termination of this agreement on mutually accepted terms, both parties shall jointly agree on continued and/or one time payment of all pending and/or future commissions to either party for all ongoing projects.
- 11.6 On termination of this agreement the parties shall perform their obligations for existing workshops and training programs at the time of such termination.

12. Notices

- 12.1 Any notice, demand or other communication given or made under or in connection with the matters contemplated by this Agreement shall be in writing and in English and delivered, personally, by courier, registered airmail or by facsimile confirmed by transmittal report, to the Parties to addresses mentioned in the recitals of this agreement.
- 12.2 Any change in the addresses of any Party shall be notified by one party to the other within 30 days of the change in address.

13. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, negotiations, and discussions with respect to the subject matter hereof whether oral or written.

14. Force Majeure

The performance of any part of this agreement by the Consultant Company or Client College shall be excused to the extent that such performance is hindered, delayed, or made impractical by flood, fire, war, or riot or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of either party. Upon the occurrence of any such event the party whose performance is affected shall notify the other party of such an occurrence.

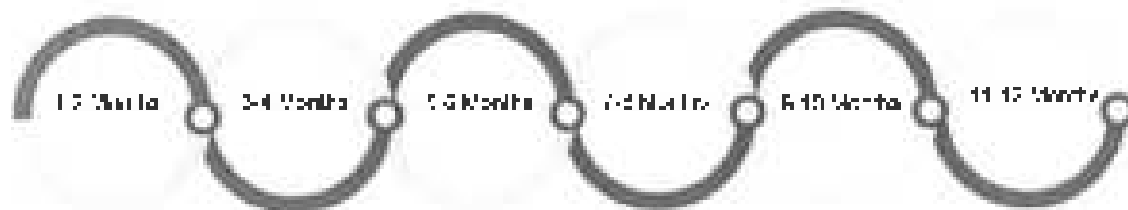

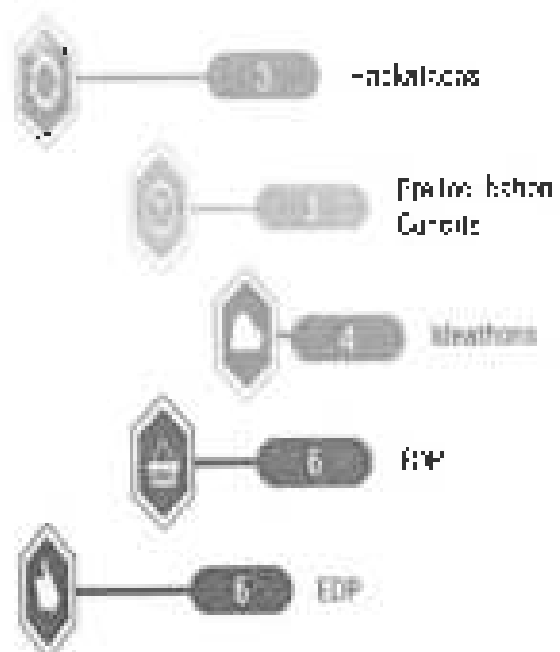
